



# Free Hot Chicken For A Year

## THE RULES

Guests **MUST** be 18 years of age or older.

No one may participate without a valid, government issued photo I.D.

It's always exciting when a new Hot Chicken Restaurant opens, but it's especially rewarding for 100 people who will be chosen to participate in the Grand Opening at Joella's Hot Chicken. Those participants who comply with the official rules will receive a Grand Prize of one Joella's Chicken Meal per week for a Year!

Our Free Hot Chicken for a Year is an opportunity for our team members to connect with the community they will be serving and get to know the neighbors. As such, participation will be open to residents who live in geographic proximity to the restaurant.

The Middletown location eligible zip codes are:

Q. What if I go to a University or College inside the zip code area, but do not live in the zip code area?

If you bring a current, valid, Student ID, you may use this ID to establish your eligibility.

Q. Why can't I participate if I don't live in the area?

Our Free Hot Chicken for a Year is an opportunity for our team members to meet future guests who live in the local community and whom our team members will be serving.

Q. What if I work inside the zip code area but do not live in the zip code area?

Only those who reside within the specific zip codes are eligible to participate.

Q. What do I need to provide to show that I live in the zip code area?

You may use your U.S. Government-issued photo ID.

Q. How are the zip codes chosen?

We select the zip codes by drawing a radius around the restaurant. We include all zip codes that fall within that radius. The radius differs by restaurant based on population.

Q. What if my ID does not list my current address/zip code?

If this applies, we will accept any of the following as proof of your zip code (A valid U.S. Government-issued ID is still required to participate in the event):

1. Federal, state, or local government documents issued within the last 90 days
2. Valid vehicle registration
3. Valid life, health, auto, or home insurance policy or card
4. Valid real estate tax statement or receipt
5. Any valid license reflecting your address (nursing, law, teaching, fishing, etc.)
6. Voter registration card
7. Current mortgage, lease, or rental agreement
